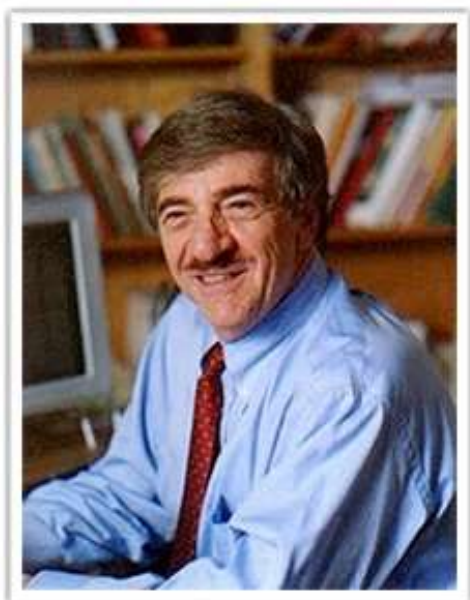




JOIN US FOR OUR ANNUAL FALL CONFERENCE
